

Question 1: Are CHP fuel cells considered eligible technology?

A: By definition CHP or cogeneration means the sequential use of energy for the production of electrical and useful thermal energy. If a fuel cell meets this definition it will be considered as eligible CHP technology. Additionally, each CHP facility should meet the efficiency performance requirements.

Question 2: Do we have to find the sites or will SDG&E find the potential sites?

A: The developer is responsible to find and secure the site. Please check the CHP RFO document for site requirements (3.0.Eligibility Requirements; A.6).

Question 3: Is 5 MW a minimum size of the plant? Is there a max size?

A: Any CHP facility with a nameplate larger than 5MW may bid into the CHP RFO. This RFO does not have an upper limit.

Question 4: Would the projects outside of CA be considered for this RFO?

A: The CHP Settlement was designed and implemented for the state of CA; it is our understanding that only projects located in the state of CA would be eligible for this RFO.
