SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY NOTIFICATION OF APPLICATION FOR ERRA FORECAST AND NOTICE OF POTENTIAL IMPACT ON ELECTRIC RATES APPLICATION NO. A.11-09-022

On September 30, 2011, San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E®) filed an application with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) for approval of its forecasted electric procurement revenue requirement for 2012, referred to as SDG&E's 2012 Energy Resource Recovery Account (ERRA) Forecast Application (ERRA Application). SDG&E requested approval of a forecasted 2012 ERRA revenue requirement of \$886.5 million and a 2012 Competition Transition Charge Revenue Requirement of \$66.1 million, an increase from 2011 levels. These revenue requirements cover the costs of acquiring power for retail customers, including costs to purchase power under contracts with various power suppliers. California Independent System Operator charges and collateral requirements associated with electric procurement. as well as the cost responsibility of Direct Access (DA) customers and Community Choice Aggregation customers for above-market costs associated with the California Department of Water Resources power costs.

ILLUSTRATIVE IMPACT ON ELECTRIC RATES AND BILLS

If the CPUC approves SDG&E's request, a typical non-CARE residential customer living in the inland climate zone and using 500 kilowatt-hours per month could see a monthly summer bill increase of 1.8%, or \$1.47. A typical monthly electric bill could increase from \$81.21 to \$82.68. For DA, the Utility Distribution Company (UDC) rate impacts on a class average basis are presented below. The percentages shown do not necessarily reflect the changes that you may see on your bill. Changes in individual bills will also depend on how much electricity each customer uses
