Dear Mr. Lyons:

On September 1, 2017, San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) filed revisions to its transmission owner tariff. SDG&E proposes to revise Appendix IV (Notices) to update the designated SDG&E representatives for notices, and Appendix IX (End Use Customer Class Transmission Charges) to change its time-of-use on-peak period rate design to be consistent with California Public Utility Commission Decision 17-08-030. SDG&E's tariff revisions are accepted for filing, effective December 1, 2017, as requested.

The filing was noticed on September 1, 2017, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before September 22, 2017. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against SDG&E.

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This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
