New Pre-Application Process FAQ

What is the new Pre-Application Process?

• In an effort to address free ridership, SDG&E is implementing a Pre-Application Process that applies to all Energy Efficiency Business Incentive (EEBI) projects.

What is free ridership?

 "In the context of energy efficiency programs, free riders are those program participants who would have undertaken the energy efficiency activity in the absence of the program." D.07-09-043

Why do we need a new process?

- Commission Staff recently issued a report highlighting that the investor owned utilities (IOUs) need to take additional steps to address free ridership AND that current efforts are inadequate.
- To prevent additional delays in the Custom Measure & Project Archive (CMPA) process

When does it go into effect?

• Effective Tuesday, September 1, 2015, all Business Incentive projects must include a signed Pre-Application Information Form. Signatures will be required by the customer as well as the project sponsor/Trade Professional.

Does this policy apply to projects submitted prior to September 1, 2015?

Projects submitted prior to September 1, 2015 must include a Pre-Application
 Information Form *only* if the customer has an assigned SDG&E Account Executive. The
 form is not required to be signed by the customer or project sponsor/Trade
 Professional.

How do I comply?

- Early engagement with assigned SDG&E Account Executive. If you don't know who the assigned Account Executive is, contact the Energy Savings Center at 1-800-644-6133 or <u>BusinessEnergySavings@sdge.com</u>.
- The 2013-2015 Pre-Application Information Form *must* be signed and submitted to the Account Executive as early as possible in the project development process. A copy of the Pre-Application Information Form should also be sent to BusinessEnergySavings@sdge.com.
- Participation in one of SDG&E's Integrated Demand Side Management (IDSM) audit programs is preferred prior to submittal to the EEBI program, but not required. Please contact BusinessEnergySavings@sdge.com for more information.
- If the Pre-Application Information Form is not provided, the project will be subject to additional delays and a *Notice-To-Proceed* will not be issued.
